June Final Exam Schedule: All teacher-directed final exams have been scheduled. Students are required to write these exams on the scheduled date at the scheduled time unless they have made an application to their grade level administrator to have the exam waived due to significant extenuating circumstances. These circumstances will align with Alberta Education standards. Students who do not attend at the scheduled time or do not have a waiver approved, will receive a mark of zero for the final exam and will have a final grade for the course submitted to Alberta Education. These students will have the opportunity to write a make-up final exam on August 22 at 9 am. A re-calculated final grade will be submitted to Alberta Education at that time.
