Students will be responsible for covering the cost of their visa to China, passport, travel insurance and \$1,000 toward their round-trip airfare to China. Alberta Education will cover the remaining costs for each student's international flight itinerary. Domestic costs, such as accommodation, food and sightseeing in China, will be covered by Hanban and the Government of the People's Republic of China.
