ALBERTA STUDENT NUMBER

The ASN is the single unique identifier for all Alberta learners. Through the use of the ASN, the education communities in Alberta will have better information to evaluate programming and emerging trends in student choices across the education system. This will lead to improved programs and services for students and improved administrative efficiency for the education system. It is also required to be able to process your application for a scholarship. If you do not know your ASN or need to have an ASN assigned (if you moved to Alberta from another province or country), search for Alberta Student Number at www.education.alberta.ca and enter the Learner Registry. You can also call 780-427-5318 or toll free in Alberta 31-0000 for a Request for Alberta Student Number Form.

SOCIAL INSURANCE NUMBER

ALBERTA RESIDENCY

The applicant must be an Alberta resident – the applicant or the applicant's parent(s) must have resided in Alberta during the qualifying grades.

SIGNATURE OF APPLICANT

The application form must be signed and dated in ink.

APPEALS (Alexander Rutherford)

In the event of a mark change send a revised Alberta Education transcript or course mark statement to Alberta Scholarship Programs.
