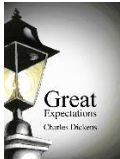

## *Great Expectations*

'Great Expectations' is a classic novel by Charles Dickens in which orphan Pip becomes a gentleman when his life is transformed by a mystery benefactor. Set among marshes in Kent, and in London, in the early to mid-1800s, the story contains some of Dickens' most memorable scenes, including the opening, in a graveyard, where the young Pip is accosted by the escaped convict, Abel Magwitch. *Great Expectations* is full of extreme imagery – poverty; prison ships and chains, and fights to the death – and has a colorful cast of characters who have entered popular culture. These include the eccentric Miss Havisham, the beautiful but cold Estella, and Joe, the kind and generous blacksmith. Dickens's themes include wealth and poverty, love and rejection, and the eventual triumph of good over evil. *Great Expectations* is popular both with readers and literary critics, and has been translated into many languages, and adapted numerous times into various media.

When Randle Patrick McMurphy gets transferred for evaluation from a prison farm to a mental institution, he assumes it will be a less restrictive environment. But the infamous Nurse Ratched runs the psychiatric ward with an iron fist, keeping her patients cowed through abuse, medication and sessions of electroconvulsive therapy. The battle of wills between the rebellious McMurphy and the inflexible Ratched soon affects all the patients in the ward. 'One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest' received five Oscars in the top five categories in 1976. It stands the test of time as being one of the most controversial and influential stories of its time.

*Maybe Baby, It's You* is a comedy about the search for that most elusive of entities, the soul mate, and told in a series of 11 vignettes that cover ground from the first kiss to the not-so-golden years of marriage. We take a raucous ride through male-female relationships with two searchers with a laundry list of must-have qualities for a mate that swiftly dwindles down to "warm and breathing" as the only prerequisite; a mild-mannered Midwesterner whose blind date turns out to be the Greek goddess Medea; a film noir couple who realize that their razor-sharp banter is hiding their fear and vulnerability; a gorgeous, charming brain surgeon who is always "Mr. Wrong" due to his penchant for spastic, arrhythmic club dancing; a couple celebrating their wedding anniversary who realize that marriage may not have ended their search for a soul mate; an elderly divorced couple who entertain the fantasy of a reconciliation at their grandson's soccer game; and other would-be and shouldn't-be couples trying to find each other.

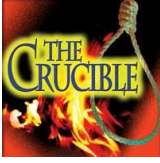

## *The Crucible*

The Crucible is a 1953 play by the American playwright Arthur Miller. It is centered around the Salem Massachusetts witch trials of 1692 where a small group of teen girls are caught in an innocent conjuring of love potions. In doing so, they are forced to tell lies that Satan had invaded them and they are then forced to name those involved in the rituals. Thrown into the mix are greedy preachers, landowners trying to steal others' land and one young woman infatuated with a married man and determined to get rid of his innocent wife. Arthur Miller wrote the event, and the subsequent trials where those who demanded their innocence were executed, those who would not name names were incarcerated and tortured, and those who admitted their guilt were immediately freed as a parable of the Congressional Communist witch hunts led by Senator Joe McCarthy in 1950's America.
